3. Why is it comforting enough to “fear no evil” because “Thou art with me?” What character traits of God make Him far more comforting to be with than another human?
4. Faithful tells Christian that “there were, as I said, a great talk thereabout, yet I do not think they did firmly believe it.” How is this similar to the world’s culture regarding Christianity?
5. What were some of the other difficulties Faithful recounted to Christian? Do you face those difficulties?
